ARRIVAL TIME

The Children's Council is charged with the responsibility of developing, implementing, and evaluating the process for recruiting, screening, selecting, training, and supervising adult volunteers.

Volunteers

- Be a member of the church for at least 6 months
- Complete a Delaney KIDS
 Ministry Application
- Complete a Background Check Form

Delaney **KIDS** Ministry will

- Review Application & Background Check
- Interview & Place Volunteer in Most Appropriate Role
- Place volunteer with Leader for a minimum of 2 weeks for training in new role

Behavior of Adults

Adults who serve with preschool and children must be held to a higher standard of behavior. At all times they should operate as if preschoolers and children are observing the adults' behavior.

Adults should be positive and strive to be inspiring Christian role models. They must be aware of the language they use and should always encourage others to further their own spiritual journey.

Two Adult Rule

Two non-related adults must be present at all non-classroom programs or activities involving preschoolers and children, one of whom must be a screened adult. All activities involving preschoolers and children must be supervised by at least one screened adult.

Open Door Policy

Parents, pastors, or church personnel have the right to visit and observe preschool and children activities or church sponsored programs at any time, unannounced. All rooms in which preschool and children activities are taking place should either be easily viewed through a window or open door.
