**Sunday, APRIL 20, 9am**

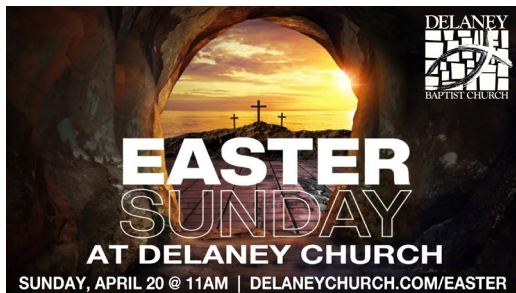

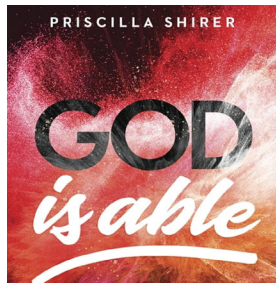
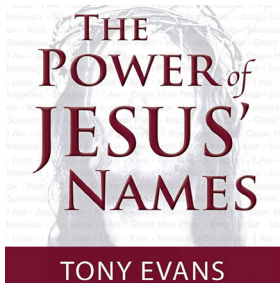

# HOLY WEEK EMPHASIS

Holy Week honors the time of Jesus' life beginning with Palm Sunday, remembering Jesus and His sacrifice on the cross, and finishing the week on Easter Sunday and the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Each day we will remember the event from the life of Christ in the Gospels that occurred on that day, and have a response to that event as we prepare to devote ourselves to the Lord.

## Sunday- April 13, Palm Sunday

EVENT: (Luke 19:28-44) Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday and Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem riding on a donkey. Jesus' humble entry fulfilled the prophecy in Zechariah 9:9 "Behold, your King is coming to you." The people shouted "Hosanna!" which means "Save now!"

RESPONSE: Let us begin this time of Holy Week with prayer and song of thanksgiving as we consecrate ourselves. Sing your favorite songs of praise and give God praise for who He is. Praise Him for His attributes (His Holiness, His Mercy, His abundant Grace, His Love, His Sovereignty, etc.)

## Monday- April 14

EVENT: (Matthew 21:12-22/Luke 19:45-48) Jesus on Holy Monday cursed the fig tree that bore no fruit, and He cleansed the temple. These acts underline the theme of integrity and preparation for what is to come.

RESPONSE: Spend time in prayer humbling confessing your sins and shortcomings while also thanking God for His forgiveness.

## Tuesday- April 15

EVENT: (Mark 11:20-13:37) The mood on Holy Tuesday is somber as Jesus speaks of coming death. He debates with the religious leaders and exposes their hypocrisy.

RESPONSE: The religious leaders were always fussing and complaining about Jesus. We are to be people of joy. So, in response to this, practice a day free of complaining - No Complaining Tuesday!

## Wednesday- April 16

EVENT: (Luke 22:3-6) Holy Wednesday is also called Spy Wednesday because this is the day that the Sanhedrin plot to kill Jesus and Judas agrees to betray Jesus.

RESPONSE: This day is a reminder of our human fallibility. Read Psalm 8 aloud and praise God for His Infinite Mercy.

## Thursday- April 17, Maundy Thursday

EVENT: (John 13:1-38) Maundy Thursday marks the Last Supper and also Jesus washing the disciples' feet. Jesus also gives the command that we "love one another" ("maundy" comes from the Latin for "command").

RESPONSE: Serve, call, pray with, or encourage someone you meet this day with the love of Christ.

## Friday- April 18, Good Friday

EVENT: (John 18:28-19:37) Good Friday is where Jesus prays for us in the garden, is betrayed, tried, crucified on the cross, and dies for our sins.

RESPONSE: Read Isaiah 53.

## Saturday- April 19, Holy Saturday

EVENT: (Matthew 27:62-66) Holy Saturday is a day of quiet reflection as the body of Christ lay in the tomb. That is why the day is also called Black Saturday.

RESPONSE: Pray for the lost. Pray for the families who will attend our Easter Fest today. Pray for the services at Delaney tomorrow. Pray for the worship of Jesus around the world. Pray for your friends you have invited to the Easter service.

## Sunday- April 20, Easter- Resurrection Day

EVENT: (Luke 24:1-49) Jesus Christ has risen from the grave! The Tomb is empty!

RESPONSE: Come to the Easter service with joy in your heart and praise on your lips.
